Shirts	Polo Shirt with collar and sleeves	Green/Black Uniform Shirt

Shorts	Regular length of above knee	Black
Skirts	Netball, a-line, wrap or skorts	Black Netball, a-line, wrap or skorts
Hats	Full brimmed, surf hat or legionnaire style	Suitable colour – may have school logo. Reversible with House Colour Available @ office
Winter Wear	Tracksuit bottoms	Black
	Jumper	Bottle green
	Jacket	Bottle green Taslon Jacket
Footwear	Fully enclosed shoes/joggers with laces	Suitable colour
Socks	Short or long	Suitable colour
“House” shirt	Polo shirt with collar and sleeves	Red, Blue or yellow (according to your sports house)
Jewellery	Rings	Signet ring only
	Earrings – one pair	Studs or sleepers only
	Watch	Own choice
Hair	Hair ties/bands/ribbons	White, green or black preferred

Items that are NOT acceptable	
Caps	Students wearing caps will not be included in any outdoor activities including play break (play on the oval)
T-shirts	Students wearing t-shirts will not be permitted to be involved in outdoor activities
Thongs/ Sandals/ Slip on shoes	It is not acceptable for this footwear to be worn, but if for medical reasons thongs/sandals have to be worn, we would need to see a doctor's certificate.
Singlet Tops/ Tank Tops/ Midriff Tops	If your child is wearing one of these tops you will be contacted to bring a suitable shirt to the school for them to change into.

Jewellery - No other jewellery is permitted. If a child is wearing more than the permitted jewellery, it could be confiscated and parents asked to collect.
