Under this agreement for 2022 Caboolture State School will receive

\$277,138*

This funding will be used to

- Ensure 100% of students will meet the National Minimum Standard (NMS) in Reading and Numeracy in 2022. If a student does not meet the NMS a Support Plan will be developed to address their specific learning needs. This plan may take the form of an Individual Curriculum Plan, a Personalised Learning Plan or additional classroom support.
- Increase the number of students in the Upper 2 Bands in Reading: Year 3 to 35% and Year 5 to 25%; in Numeracy: Year 3 to 35% and Year 5 to 30%.
- Target teaching and intervention programs in Prep to Year 2, focussing on the development of phonological awareness, reading and numeracy.
- Increase student attendance rates to greater than 90%.
- Provide professional development for Prep to Year 6 teachers in relation to Intentional Collaboration.

Our initiatives include

- Providing extensive professional development for teaching staff and teacher aides, through the continuation of Professional Learning Communities and peer observations and feedback in targeted areas in Literacy and Numeracy.
- Continuing implementation and monitoring through our pedagogical framework, consistent practices in the teaching of guided Reading, Writing, Spelling and Numeracy.
- Continuing to align all Support Teacher: Literacy and Numeracy support and specialised services to school curriculum plan priorities.
- Continuing to use school data sets in planning, reviewing and refining all teaching and learning programs through team meetings with teachers and support staff each term.
- Implementing consistent teaching practices across the Prep to Year 6 cohort, in particular the use of Visible Learning.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

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| • Utilising school data sets to inform development of personal learning plans for identified students in Prep – Year 6. | \$ 5 000 |
| • Providing opportunities for all staff to access professional development opportunities, including best pedagogical practice in teaching of Literacy, Spelling, Numeracy and Visible Learning. | \$ 10 000 |
| • Providing intensive small group support for students not meeting the National Minimum Standard through Fly In Squads. | \$262 138 |
